### freedom fact:

Children are uniquely vulnerable to military recruitment because of their emotional and physical immaturity. They are easily manipulated and can be drawn into violence that they are too young to resist or understand. Children are most likely to become child soldiers if they are poor, separated from their families, displaced from their homes, living in a combat zone or have limited access to education.

#### prayer:

Lord of Light, the world seems so dark. When children are abused because of their innocence and orphans because of their loneliness, the world seems dark. We are looking for light. Be light in darkness. Make crooked roads straight. Turn bloodstained hands into hands that can work for justice. And, please, use my voice as one who calls for justice. Amen.
